





1. PREAMBLE

Collaborative efforts in education are need of hour to share domain specific strategic knowledge and institutional resources. The institutions are entering into MOUs with organizations having similar mandate on viable collaborative platforms for both knowledge dissemination and ground actions. The collaboration could be in the areas of projects, students and faculty/professionals exchange, joint publications, joint sponsored academic projects, joint faculty and staff development programmes etc. The above two institutions signing this MOU have agreed to work on the points mentioned in the preamble.


2. PURPOSE



This MOU is purely for academic purpose and it will not carry any financial implications on both the organizations.

3. AREA OF COLLABORATION

Both institutes i.e. WALMI, Bhopal and Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukharjee Sci. & Comm. PG College Bhopal agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the areas of sustainable development studies and activities on the basis of the equality and reciprocity.

a. Faculty exchange

- Conducting Lectures related to Natural Resources Management.
- Undertaking joint research.
- Attachment of staff for the purpose of curriculum development and upgrading of research skills.
- Participating in seminars, workshops, conferences, symposiums and other types of academic discussions.
- Conducting joint consultancy work.
- Undertaking job oriented project work.
- Exchange information on the fairs pertaining to placement, training and placement drives.
- Jointly organize placement drives.

b. Skill Development /Training Programmes


- I. To exchange information on Skill Development/Project Work/Apprentiship/ Enterprunership, Training Programmes.
- II. To jointly organize short term Skill Development/Training Programmes for interns.


c. Entrepreneurial Activities

- I. To exchange information on Entrepreneurial Activities.
- II. To jointly organize Entrepreneurial Workshops and training activities and to invite each other to participate therein.
- III. To promote and encourage students of UG & PG for entrepreneurs.
- IV. To utilize the services of trained interns for various related projects on honorarium basis as per the norms set by both organizations.

d. Other areas

- I. To exchange information on research and educational programmes.
- II. To exchange information on literature relevant to educational, Teaching and research programmes.
- III. To jointly organize short term continuing education programmes on topics and issues pertaining to sustainable development and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- IV. To organize jointly seminars, conference and workshops on topics and issues pertaining to sustainable development and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.

- V. To propose and engage jointly in research or training programme sponsored by funding agencies and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- VI. The provisions of culture and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes.
- VII. To use laboratory facilities in specific cases with prior information.
- VIII. Any other activity not mentioned in the MOU shall be decided on case basis by the two signing institutions i.e. WALMI, Bhopal & Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukharjee Sci. & Comm. PG College Bhopal

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity: setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and Conditions for each activity or such exchange including those concerning monetary implications will be worked out between the institutes.

4. COORDINATION

Head of the Department and senior officer nominated by the Director of WALMI, Bhopal will coordinate the programme Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukharjee Sci. & Comm. PG College Bhopal and a Program Coordinator from the side of WALMI will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

5. VALIDITY

The memorandum shall remain in force for a period of five financial years commencing from effective date and may be renewed or discontinued thereafter by mutual consent.

6. TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice of three months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukharjee Sci. & Comm. PG College Bhopal nor WALMI, Bhopal will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, both the signing parties shall ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

7. AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by representatives of both institutions.

Participating faculties, Staff and Students involved in any activities under this memorandum must adhere to the law of the country and rules and regulations of the institutions.


9. LEGAL EFFECT


10. CONFLICT RESOLUTIONS



MONU VARMA, THE SECOND PARTY, and represented herein by its Zonal / Divisional Head, MONU VARMA, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- (i) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:
GOVERNMENT DR SHYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJEE SCIENCE & COMMERCE PG COLLEGE, KOLAR ROAD, BHOPAL(M.P)
- A) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- B) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- C) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- D) GURU KRIPA OIL AND FOODS, KULAS KALAN, SEHORE (M.P.) PROPRIETOR MR. MONU VARMA, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Manufacturing, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services in the fields of **MARKETING , LISIONING, CORPORATE RELATIONSHIP, FRONT OFFICE DESK MANAGEMENT , BUISNESS DEVELOPMENT** and related fields
- E) GURU KRIPA OIL AND FOODS, KULAS KALAN, SEHORE (M.P.) PROPRIETOR MR. MONU VARMA, the Second Party is promoted by MONU VARMA Group; Address and background of the Company.
- F) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the industry concerned with whom the MOU is sworn.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS

CLAUSE 1
CO-OPERATION

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2
SCOPE OF THE MOU

The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology/ Field Project Work/ Internship/ Apprenticeship and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students of UG & PG Classes fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Applied Botany.

Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for at least 10% of the students. The Second Party will itself absorb at least 10 percentage of the trained students.

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.

There is no financial commitment on the part of **GOVERNMENT DR SHYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJEE SCIENCE & COMMERCE PG COLLEGE, KOLAR ROAD, BHOPAL(M.P.)** the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MOU.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **GURU KRIPA OIL AND FOODS, KULAS KALAN, SEHORE (M.P.)** PROPRIETOR **MR. MONU VARMA**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or **GURU KRIPA OIL AND FOODS, KULAS KALAN, SEHORE (M.P.) PROPRIETOR MR. MONU VARMA**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.

Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

**CLAUSE 5
RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.



The representatives of Institute for **GOVERNMENT DR. SHYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJEE SCIENCE AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, BHOPAL** and **SCAN RESEARCH LABORATORIES, BHOPAL (M.P.)**, agree to this memorandum of Understanding.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes the following:

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT

To establish a mutually beneficial relationship built on academic and scientific cooperation. Areas of cooperation between the **GOVERNMENT DR. ARTICLE – I: SCOPE OF THE MOU

This MOU incorporates modalities and general conditions regarding collaboration between IES University and Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal, for enhancing, **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE, RESEARCH and SKILL DEVELOPMENT, Internship and Project Work** by mutual consent, by maintaining prejudice to prevailing rules and regulations of IES University and Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal, without any disregard any mechanism evolved and approved by the Competent Authorities under **the provisions of** Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and Govt. of India. The areas of cooperation can be extended through mutual consent in future.

ARTICLE - II: SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

- a) Exchange of personnel on short term basis as per the rules of the respective institute.
 - b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars, student project works for **ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENT/RESEARCH** and other areas of national interest at IES University by Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal or vice versa on mutually agreeable terms.
 - c) Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal would accommodate trainees of Skill Development Modules, Diploma, Degree and all PG students whom Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal deems convenient to it for the purpose of imparting training. Same would be reciprocated by IES University.
 - d) Both the partners shall allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them exposure to various equipment, instruments, etc at the Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal, IES University, Bhopal or any other allotted authorised premises.
- However, such arrangements can be made by mutual agreement only if the schedules and time tables of both the parties are not disturbed.



ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a) IES University and Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal may depute their personnel as visiting faculties/trainers at each other's premises to teach or impart training on any regular Course or specialized topics to promote academic excellence and research interaction.
- b) IES University and Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal shall permit the sharing of software, ICT tools and other materials and components developed in-house in the areas of cooperation if permissible within the rules governing the two institutions. However, responsibility for safety of software and other materials during the exchange will be of both the parties.

ARTICLE-IV: COORDINATION OF THE PROGRAMME INCLUDING FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- a) The collaborative Program between IES University and Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Science and commerce College, Bhopal shall be coordinated by an appointed coordination committee by the competent Authority i.e., **Head of both the institutes.**

ARTICLE – VIII: RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES





