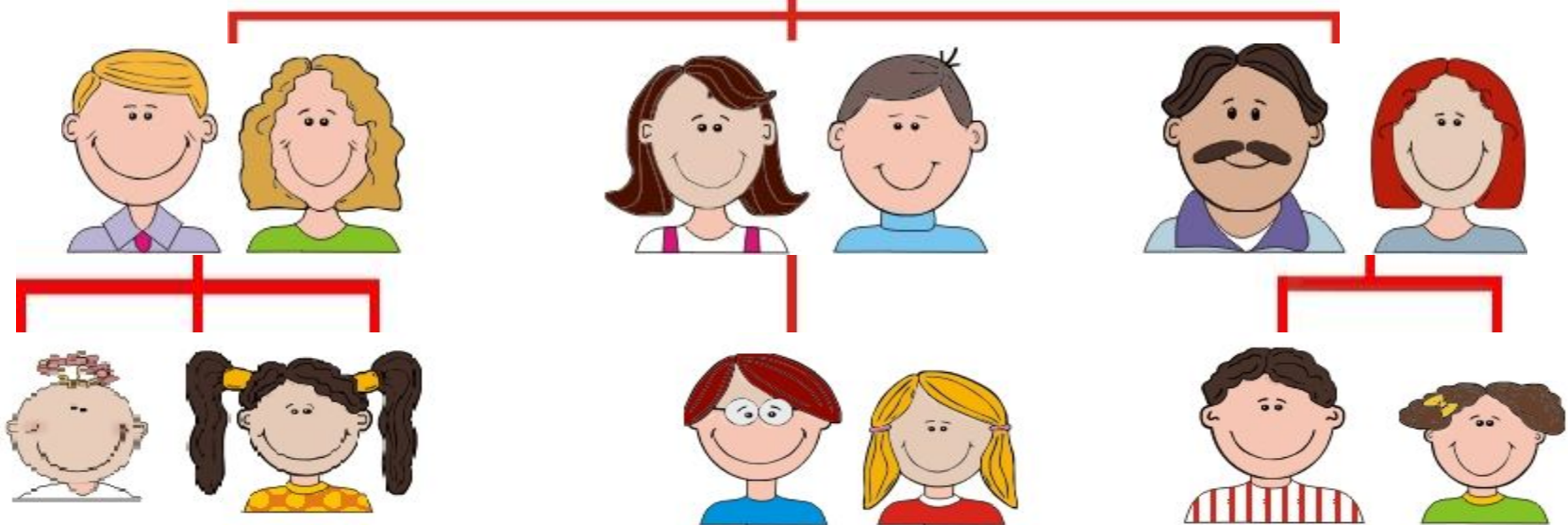

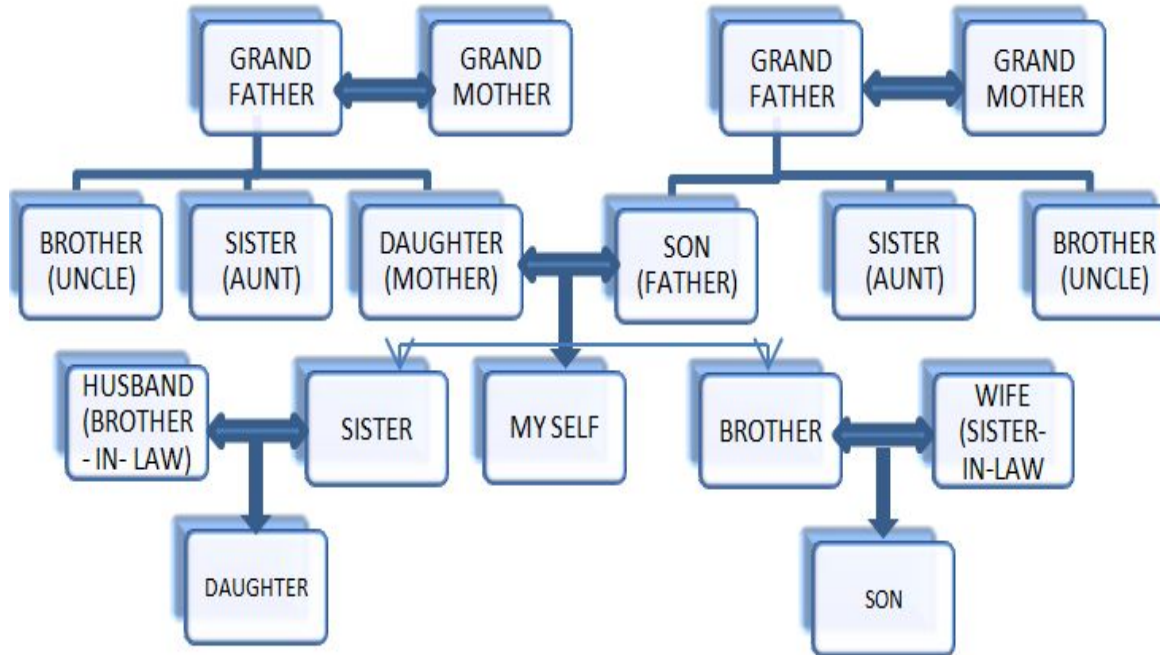

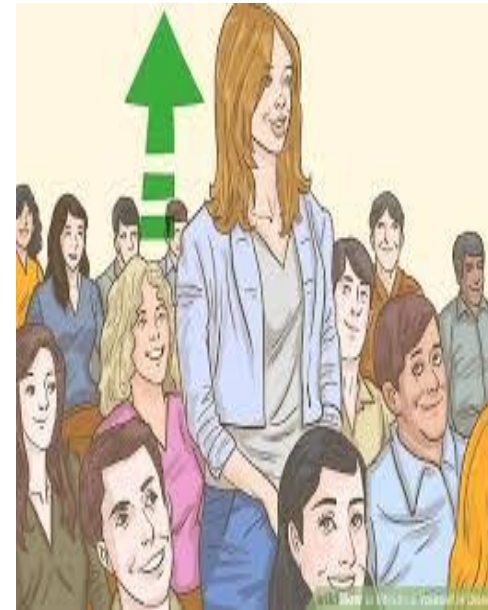
Example
