

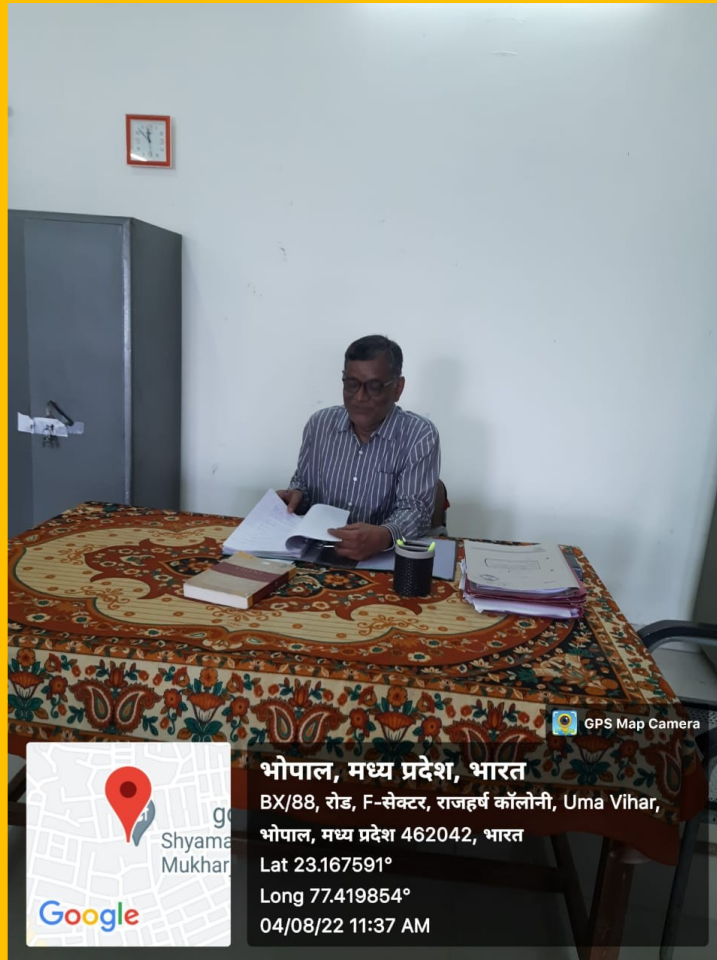

Office of President

- Two types of executive in parliamentary system.
- Head of State i.e., President of India.
- Head of Government i.e., Cabinet headed by Prime Minister.
- The office of president has following attributes.


Immunities of President

- President is first citizen of Republic of India.
- He is not answerable to any court for the exercise of the duties of his office.
- Bar to criminal proceedings during his term of office
- No process for arrest or imprisonment during his term of office
- Bar to civil proceedings unless two months of notice in writing given to president

Discretion in certain exigencies

- Governor to exercise some functions in his discretion [Article 143(1)]. No such provision for president.
- Death or resignation of prime minister.
- Appointment of prime minister when party position in Lok Sabha is uncertain.
- Demand of dissolution by the prime minister defeated on the floor of the house.

- Constitution 42nd amendment act 1976.
- Has amended Article 74(1) to make the advice of council of ministers obligatory for the president.
- Constitution 44th amendment act 1978.
- Added proviso to Article 74 of Constitution of India requiring council of ministers to reconsider its advice but president shall act in accordance with advice tendered after such reconsideration. In following marginal cases, he can be justified to act in his discretion due to exigency of the situation.
